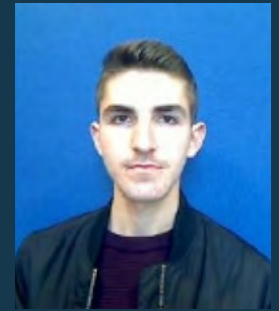

## FHS Student Receives University Scholarship

Benjamin Lekaj 13T has won a prestigious scholarship with the multinational investment bank and financial services company Credit Suisse. Credit Suisse will sponsor Ben through university, paying for his tuition fees (£27.5K) and offering him work placements in the holidays. He has a place to study Maths and Economics at LSE in September.



We interviewed Ben about this exciting opportunity.

### How did you find out about the scholarship?

I was looking for work experience opportunities in Year 12 and came across this opportunity with Credit Suisse and thought I'd apply.

### How did the selection process work?

First I submitted a CV and cover letter. Then I had 15-minute phone interview. The next stage was an assessment centre at the bank in Canary Wharf – 35 of us were selected to go to the assessment centre.

### What's an assessment centre?

It's a full day of selection activities including presentations and scenarios which you have to respond to. There was also a Maths exam and an in-tray exercise. It was pretty tough!

### What happened next?

15 of us were selected for 1-1 interviews with Managing Directors from the company and then there was a final interview with two directors and five of us were successful.

### Was there lots of competition for the scholarship?

5,000 people applied!

### Wow that's an amazing achievement! Are there any conditions to the offer?

Yes I need to get 3 As at A-Level and a 2:1 degree. I'll have to work over the summers though I'll get paid.

### What are you most looking forward to about university?

Everything really, the independence, the advanced study, meeting new people...

### Why do you want to be an investment banker?

It's a demanding job and you get an insight into the financial world. I should also get to use my German. And the pay's not bad either!

### How can other students find out about the opportunity?

They should google Credit Suisse Steps to Success programme.
