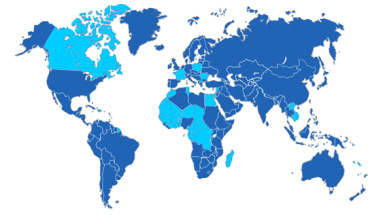


Dear Students,
