
## How work will be set during the school closure

The following slides give detailed information with a step-by-step guide for students to check Show My Homework for the work set by their teachers during the period of school closure. Please assist your son to ensure he is confident in its use so he is able to maintain his learning and progress using this tool over the period of closure.

- Show My Homework (SMHW) will be used to set all of the work that your son will be given.
- ► Each day, your son will need to log-in to SMHW and complete the work set.
- Your son should be able to access SMHW, but if he cannot then these are the options:
  - Re-set his password through your SMHW parent account
  - Get your son to use 'forgot password'
  - E-mail school for a new pin (office@foresthillschool.co.uk) please enter SMHW PIN in the subject line
- Please check your own parent account to look at the work set.
- If the work has not been set, then e-mail the school (<a href="mailto:office@foresthillschool.co.uk">office@foresthillschool.co.uk</a>) and we will try to address the situation.

## Feedback on the work set

- Some of the work that teachers set will need to be completed by your son and submitted back to the teacher through SMHW.
- ► Teachers will then provide feedback which your son will be expected to act on.



## How can you help?

- Monitor your son's work carefully.
- ► Talk to your son about the work. Without a teacher to explain the work it can be challenging to understand and any adult intervention can be helpful.
- Make sure the work that needs to be submitted is completed by your son and uploaded by the deadline.
- Any other resources that you can provide will be useful e.g. revision guides, paper, etc.

## Other advice

- There are many resources that are free and very helpful, such as Seneca Learning.
- For science and languages we will send you a log-in for Kerboodle which is an excellent on-line resource.
- Try to structure your son's day.
- Year 11 and Year 13 students are a special concern because of exams, but please try to be positive with them.
