


How to use Seneca Learning

Seneca Learning is a free online learning tool which helps teach students key information on a variety of topics. See below for key information about it



How do I logon?

To log on to Seneca you need to create your own account. Seneca does not work on Microsoft Internet Explorer, you need to use Google Chrome or Firebox. To create the account follow the instructions below

1. Go to www.senecalearning.com and click on Sign Up



Joining a Class on Seneca


If your teacher has told you to join Seneca they will have most likely set up a class page.

To access your class page


1. Click on Classes and Assignments



2. Click on Join Class in the top right corner




3. Enter the class code and you will be taken to the class page where you will find assignments and courses to complete
