Arrangements for the start of Autumn Term 2021

Dear Parents and Carers

It is most regrettable that our summer term has ended with the need to close school to students for the last few days of term. With a staff member testing positive, and a high number of staff being required to self-isolate, it has proved impossible for reasons of health and safety to keep the school open to students. This is disappointing, and not the term-end we would have wished for.

However, we are optimistic for the full opening of school in the Autumn term, and with 'normal routines' for all year groups from Friday 3rd September. Students will no longer be taught in 'bubbles' nor be expected to maintain social distancing. **However, we will still be expecting students to wear masks in communal spaces.**

The following information applies to Years 7 to 11. Information for Years 12 & 13 will follow from SFH6.

Within this letter you will find information specific to your son and his return to school in regards to the Lateral Flow Tests we will need to carry out prior to students starting their face-to-face lessons - please refer to the table below for details.

There is a lot of information in this letter and I would be grateful if you could take the time to read through carefully. However, should the government issue revised guidance prior to the start of term, we will of course, notify parents and carers as soon as possible, with advice and guidance as appropriate.

Everyone's safety - Lateral Flow Testing

Following the summer break, we have to ensure that each pupil receives two Covid-19 lateral flow tests (LFT) - one prior to their first day back, and the second during their first few days back in school, under supervision.

The testing programme is to ensure the safety of all members of the community for the start of the new academic year. In order to carry out the LFT in school (as stipulated by government), we require you to complete and return a consent form. If you have previously completed a consent form, it is not necessary to do so again. All Year 7 parents are requested to complete the form no later than **9am on Wednesday 1st September.**

Students can return to face-to-face lessons following their first negative test. Please see the table below for the planned schedule of testing for all year groups prior to their return to school. Their first day in school is also shown.

Please ensure that your son arrives at the correct allocated time for his Tutor Group, in full school uniform, via the public entrance to the Sports Hall located on Bampton Road. We are asking that you escort your son(s) to and from school to ensure maximum attendance for testing. Parking is available on local roads. You are welcome to wait outside the Sports Hall whilst your son has his test which is expected to be completed within the hour.

Following this first test, your son will leave immediately and return home. Your son's result will come through the NHS Test and Trace system to your email address and/or phone number. **As long as your son's test result comes back negative he can return to school as shown in the table above.** We will contact any pupils whose test returns a positive result, and they will be expected to immediately follow the standard guidelines for self-isolation, Test and Trace etc. The second LFT will occur in school during the following school weeks and will be carried out under appropriate supervision.

School expectations and protocols

Arrival and Dismissal - we have decided to continue with the staggered start times and students using their own dedicated entry and exit gates. You should have already received information about us reverting to early closure on Mondays.

Students will be expected to follow the procedures below:-

Travel to and from school - it is advisable for students to continue to avoid using public transport wherever possible. We suggest walking or cycling to school, even if this is a little more inconvenient than the usual way of getting to school. Students cycling to school will need to obtain a bike pass from their Head of Year.

Face coverings - although the government is lifting most of the earlier restrictions, we have decided it is prudent for us to continue with mask use for everyone when in communal areas of the school, as is the case now. Please note this expectation and ensure your son comes to school with a minimum of two masks for use during the day. Medical exemptions will continue to apply as previously.

Classrooms - your son will have his lessons taught in a range of classrooms, and be moving around the school for his different subject lessons, as in pre-Covid times. Each classroom will still have hand sanitiser etc available, enabling everyone to continue to maintain good hand hygiene.

Equipment - students must bring their own writing equipment to school each day, to be used only by them. Again, we think it advisable that there is no sharing between students.

Signage - signage around the site reminding of good practice with hand hygiene and the wearing of face coverings, will remain in place - although there will no longer be a need to socially distance.

Social times - we have decided to continue with staggered lunch and mid-morning break times - please refer to table below.

Water - all water fountains on site will be reinstated, although we continue to recommend that students also bring in their own water bottle. These can now be filled on site from the various water sources available.

Uniform - students will be expected to wear full uniform when attending school. Please ensure that your son has all items of uniform in advance of his first Lateral Flow Test in September - as stated earlier he should wear uniform to attend the test.
