# Welcome to Forest Hill School

We are delighted that your child has been offered a place at Forest Hill School to start with us in September 2024 and I would like to take this opportunity to formally welcome you to our community. ### Welcome Meeting

I would like to invite you and your child to attend a welcome meeting on **Thursday 25 April 2024 at 6.00pm (doors open at 5.45pm).** This will give us the opportunity to formally welcome you and your child to the school and to explain the process of induction. The meeting will last approximately one hour.

### Induction Assessments

As part of the induction process we will ask your child to take some simple web-based assessments. These will ensure he is placed in the right groups from the beginning of his time at the school and will allow his teachers to make sure he is receiving the appropriate challenge and level of support. These assessments will take place after school between **20-22 May 2024**. Your child will need to attend one session at Forest Hill School on one of these dates. We will write to you separately with your appointment details and more information.

### Interview

You and your child will be invited to a formal face-to-face interview in late June/early July. A letter will be sent to you nearer the time to confirm your appointment time and date. Please note that your child cannot start school without this interview. If the time is not suitable for you, please contact Caroline Calligy, Office Manager, and she will endeavour to rearrange the appointment.

### **Transition Day**

On **Tuesday 2 July 2024**, all primary school children in the borough of Lewisham will visit their secondary schools. We look forward to your child joining us for a morning of activities and a school lunch. Further details and exact timings will be sent to you in due course.
